Community input was solicited through focus groups and a community survey.

Key community stakeholders were also involved in reviewing and interpreting findings from the CHNA and developing an implementation plan to address prioritized community needs.

The community survey and focus group interviews assessed local health care access and needs of the Effingham County community. The community survey was disseminated to residents of the hospital's primary service area via the hospital's, website, social media webpages and email listservs, as well as those of local community partners. Focus group participants were all key community stakeholders of Effingham County. Three virtual focus groups were held in March 2022, with an average of 9 participants per focus group. The hospital and the CHNA steering committee recruited twenty-seven focus group participants. They included key community stakeholders representing health care, the local public health department, faith-based organizations, the chamber of commerce, and local businesses. Collectively, perspectives obtained from the surveys and focus groups provided a holistic view of life in the community and the health and health care needs of the residents.
